The Program



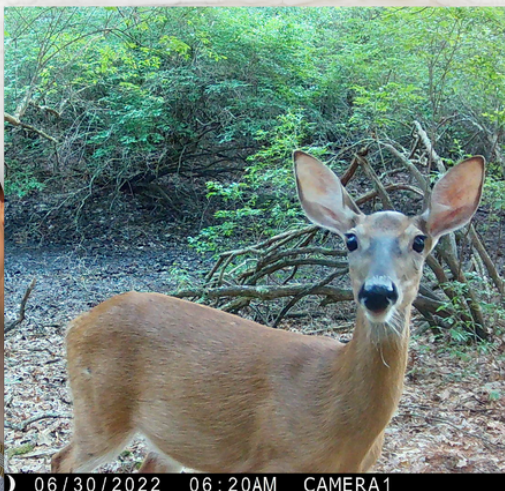
Spend 10 weeks in Mashpee on Cape Cod, ancestral homelands of the Wampanoag
